### Working Bee to aid bushfire survivors Saturday 25 th July at Castella (near Toolangi) (All day, or as much as you can)

A working bee is planned to assist the Bush Fire Recovery Group, a sub-committee of the Toolangi District Community House Inc, with potting of plants, splitting of timber and some fencing, in and around Toolangi, Castella, and Kinglake. Plants will be distributed to families whose gardens have been destroyed or damaged by the fires. Castella is a one hour drive from Glen Waverley, off the Melba Highway. The working bee will be based at the 10 acre property of Ngairé and Jack Walhout who are coordinating the collection, potting and distribution of the plants and other landscaping needs.
